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Introduction

In WISHIN Pulse, you can view a Participant's CA:tCH Safety Plan and demographics.

Before You Begin

You must have a WISHIN Pulse user ID and Password.

Patient Summary Page

After you've logged in to WISHIN Pulse and successfully searched for and selected a Participant, the system will display the Patient Summary Page.

NOTE: The first time you open the Patient Summary page, it will contain two boxes: Allergies and Reports. You can permanently hide the Allergies box, so Reports is the only item that appears on the summary page.

Hiding the Allergies Box

- Select **Configure** on the right side of the Patient Summary (it'll appear just above the top box on the right)
- Choose the minus sign \Box next to the Allergies Section to hide it
- The Allergies section will appear in the Hidden Sections area.
- Select Save.

Options from the Patient Summary Page:

- Open a Participant Safety Plan by choosing it directly from the Reports box
- Navigate to the Reports/Results page by selecting the **All Reports** link at the bottom of the Reports box
- Navigate to the Reports/Results page by selecting the **Results** link in the left navigation bar.
- View the Participant's general demographic information by selecting the **Patient Profile** button at the top right of the page.
